How To Screenshot On iPhone

We will discuss model-wise. Because the features are different, that's why the process may be slightly changed. Let's explore:

Phones with Face ID integration:

To screenshot on iPhones with Face ID, do the following:

- Press the side button and volume up together.
- Then release the buttons quickly.
- You've taken the screenshot.
- You can even edit or dismiss below.

Phones with Touch ID and side button:

- Press the home button and the side button at a time.
- Also, release both buttons quickly.
- There you see the screenshot preview at the bottom.

iPhones with Touch ID and Top button:

- Tap the top button on iPhone and home button together.
- Then, release both buttons at the same time.
- Your screenshot is taken, and you can see the screenshot preview as well.

How To Take Full-Page Screenshots In Safari

If you're using the Safari browser for an important task and want to keep things saved there, you can take the screenshots using the given steps:

- Just take a normal screenshot first.
- Click the preview option from the bottom section.
- Tap the 'Full Page' option.
- Crop the image.
- And save the PDF.
